


**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: October 9, 2018**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers. Council Members present were Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Tom Grier, Mr. Mike Gross, Mr. Chad Johnson, Mr. Roger Moore, Ms. Jackie Salmans and Cherry Wilson, Clerk. Tom Grier made a motion to excuse Glenn Mishler, seconded by Jackie Salmans, all members voted yes. ~~Glenn Mishler made a motion to excuse President Biggers, seconded by Roger Moore, all members voted yes.~~ Also, present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor and Mr. Max Crown, Safety Service Director. 

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from 9/24/18. Tom Grier made the motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Roger Moore. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

Petitions & Remonstrance's: Tina Dobson of Hillsdale Drive said she is waiting for water. The Mayor told Ms. Dobson there is an ordinance on the agenda tonight to start the process for Hillsdale Drive to get water.

Reports of Standing or Special Committees: None.

City Officers Reports:

Mayor's Report: The Mayor went over his monthly report that was included in council packets. The Mayor thanked councilman Mike Gross for donating signage for the Street Levy. The Meet the Candidate night hosted by BPW will be October 30th at 7 pm. Ballot issues will also be spoken on.

Service Director's Report: Max Crown gave an update on the ODOT Bridge Project. He announced the water office will be closed Thursday & Friday for relocation, they will open Monday at 1100 Walnut Street.

Law Director's Report: Bob Skelton was present; with no report.

Auditor's Report: Auditor Sherry Kirkpatrick was present with no report.

Public Works Department Report: Kevin Sharier was present and gave a brief report on paving.

Property Code Investigator's Report: Jeff Corder was present, his monthly report was included in packets. He gave a brief review of some projects he has been working on.

Introduction of Ordinances:

Roger Moore made a motion to add Ordinance 41-18 to the agenda, seconded by Tom Grier, all members voted yes.

Legislation at first reading:

40-18 appropriations. After the first reading Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Chad Johnson, all members voted yes. After the second reading Tom Grier made a motion to suspend the rules and give ordinance a third reading, seconded by Mike Gross, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 40-18 passed with emergency clause.

41-18 an ordinance authorizing the Mayor or Service Director to prepare specifications, advertise and let a bid for the Hillsdale Driver Waterline Extension Project. After the first reading Jackie Salmans motion to suspend the rules and give ordinance a second reading, seconded by Brad Fuller, all members voted yes. After the second reading Chad Johnson made

a motion to suspend the rules and give ordinance a third reading, seconded by Roger Moore, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 41-18 passed with emergency clause.

Legislation at third reading:

25-18 an ordinance to amend the zoning map of the City of Coshocton for the following addresses on South 6th Street in the City of Coshocton 315, 317, 319, 321, 325, 327 & 329 and a portion of vacated alley. All members voted yes, Ordinance 25-18 passed.

34-18 an ordinance approving the addition and inclusion of certain ordinances as part of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Coshocton by the Walter Drane Company. All members voted yes, Ordinance 34-18 passed.

36-18 an ordinance not allowing camping on any property owned by the City of Coshocton. All members voted yes, Ordinance 36-18 passed.




