

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: April 22, 2019**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers. Council Members present Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Mike Gross, Mr. Chad Johnson, Mr. Glenn Mishler, Mr. Roger Moore, Ms. Jackie Salmans and Cherry Wilson, Clerk. Also, present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor and Max Crown, Safety Service Director. Glenn Mishler made a motion to excuse Mr. Tom Grier, seconded by Chad Johnson, all members voted yes.

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from 4/8/19. Jackie Salmans made the motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Roger Moore. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

Petitions & Remonstrance's: Tom Barcroft with Our Town Coshocton thanked the city for displaying the Tree City Flags in several locations.

Richard Gates of South Lawn Avenue said his situation has gotten worse with people going too fast, blowing through stop signs and riding wheelies on motorcycles. He asked about putting up a gate between the Salvation Army and the old library to stop people from accessing this area. Mr. Corder said the owners of the library will not return any of his communications. The administration said they would investigate his request.

Reports of Standing or Special Committees: None.

City Officers Reports:

Mayor's Report: Mayor Mercer asked council to pass ordinance 25-19 in three readings tonight.

Service Director's Report: Max Crown thanked everyone for helping with the City Clean up Day, he said 70-75 people showed up to help and several worked in their own neighborhoods. Very impressive the amount that was clean up that day.

Law Director's Report: Bob Skelton was present his March Report was emailed to council on 4/16/19.

Sheriff's Report: An officer was present with no report.

Auditor's Report: Auditor Sherry Kirkpatrick was present and asked for council to approve the Then and Now's dated 4/3/19 & 4/17/19 and the Detailed Check Reports dated 4/3/19 & 4/17/19. Jackie Salmans made a motion to approve the reports, seconded by Chad Johnson, all members voted yes. The reports were approved as submitted.

Property Code Investigator's Report: Jeff Corder was present with no report.

Introduction of Ordinances:

Glenn Mishler made a motion to add Ordinance 23-19 and 24-19 to the Agenda, seconded by Roger Moore, all members voted yes.

25-19 an ordinance amending Chapter 1311 Demolition of Structures of the City of Coshocton's Codified Ordinances. After the first reading Chad Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Mike Gross, all members voted yes. After the second reading Glenn Mishler made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Jackie Salmans, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 25-19 passed.

LEGISLATION AT THIRD READING

20-19 an ordinance to amend ordinance 57-18 establishing wages for those positions that are exempt from collective bargaining and adding Water Treatment Plant Superintendent and Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 20-19 passed.




