CCCO 731.06 BOND OR LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIRED

- (a) No person or company shall be granted a license to operate a taxicab, and no taxicab shall be operated on the public streets, and places of the City, unless the person or company first files with the Director of Public Safety and Service an insurance policy or bond executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State, or by one or more personal sureties approved as to sufficiency by the City Auditor, and as to form and legality by the Law Director. All personal sureties must be residents of the County and the sureties must be the owners of real estate located in the County which is liable to execution in a sum, in excess of all encumbrances, that is double the highest sums and double the total of all sums required under this section. The personal surety must present evidence of title and value to the City Auditor showing these qualifications in each instance. The amount of the insurance policy or bond shall be the minimum required by the State of Ohio.
- (b) The insurance policy required by subsection (a) hereof may provide for cancellation by the insurer upon written notice to the City Auditor, but this provision shall not be construed to waive any lawful notice which the insurer must give to the insured. On cancellation, the license covered by the policy shall be revoked by the Mayor.

The license shall expire on December 31 of the year for which it is issued.

The annual fee is twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

All vehicles must be inspected by the Coshocton County Sheriff's Office.

No person shall drive a taxicab unless he is duly licensed as a chauffeur as required by ORC 4507.01.

Every taxicab shall be kept in a safe and sanitary condition.

Whoever violates any provision of CCCO Chapter 731 for which another penalty is not provided shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor. In the event of misconduct or acts on the part of a licensed driver which show him to be an unsuitable person to drive a taxicab, or which would be sufficient to justify the refusal of a license in the case of an original applicant, the Mayor may revoke a license already granted.
