Local Emergency Declaration

AUTHORITY Whereas, the City of Coshocton, Coshocton County, State of Ohio

Has been or is immediately directly affected by the coronavirus/COVID-19 outbreak, and; the need to protect the citizens of City of Coshocton and public safety forces and medical personnel.

Now, therefore we the City of Coshocton

Declare that a State of Emergency exists in the City of Coshocton and we hereby invoke and declare those portions of the Ohio Revised Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the County for the exercise of all necessary Emergency Authority for the protection of lives and property of the people of Coshocton County and the restoration of the local government with a minimum of interruption.


Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances, resolutions, and particularly to Section 5502 of the Ohio Revised Code.

All public offices and employees of the City of Coshocton, are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required for them for the duration of the emergency and in the execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives – State and Local.

All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.

All operating forces will direct their communications and requests for assistance and operations to the Coshocton County Emergency Management Agency and/or the Emergency Operations Center.
