



City of Coshocton Contractor Information

1. The City of Coshocton imposes a local tax of 2% (effective 7-1-15) on all income earned within the city and the Franklin and Tuscarawas JEDD region. The tax is levied on all wages, salaries, commissions and any other form of compensation earned. In addition to fulfilling its own tax obligations to the city, a contractor has the responsibility of notifying its sub-contractors of the tax obligation to the City of Coshocton Income Tax.
2. For those business's located outside the City of Coshocton but employ within the city or the JEDD region, tax liability begins after 20 days of compensation earned (to determine withholding requirements refer to ORC 718.011 and 718.03).
