

**Record of Proceedings  
Coshocton City Council  
Meeting Held: January 27, 2020**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers. Council Members present, Ms. Kayley Andrews, Mr. Mike Gross, Mr. Chad Johnson, Mr. Glenn Mishler, Mr. Roger Moore, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Ms. Michelle Turner and Ms. Cherry Wilson. Also, present Mr. Mark Mills, Mayor and Mr. Max Crown, Safety Service Director.

**Previous Meeting Minutes:** President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from 1/13/20. Chad Johnson made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Roger Moore. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

**Petitions & Remonstrance's:** Tim Kohler 1310 Oak Avenue addressed council with some concerns he had with Kimble trash service.

Karen Odell of Denman Avenue also addressed council with some concerns with Kimble trash service.

**Reports of Standing or Special Committees:** None

Clerk Cherry Wilson listed reports from departments that were emailed to council: Coshocton Port Authority Monthly Report 1/14/20 and Law Director's Annual Report 1/27/20.

**City Officers Reports:**

Mayor's Report: Mayor Mills reported they are working on the trash contract and he appreciates input from the community.

The Mayor gave his State of the City Address.

Service Director's Report: Max Crown reviewed Ordinance 8-20 and asked council if they had any questions.

Law Director's Report: Bob Skelton was present his annual report was emailed to council.

Sheriff's Office Report: Sheriff Rogers was present and distributed to council a report of what his office has done since the last council meeting. The Sheriff went over some of the items on the report.

Auditor's Report: Sherry Kirkpatrick was present with no report. She had previously submitted a report to council regarding the Visa rewards available on the city credit card and she is currently having those points converted to a payment on the account.

Public Works Director Report: Kevin Sharier was present with no report.

Property Code Investigator Report: Jeff Corder was present with no report.

**Introduction of Ordinances:**

Glenn Mishler made a motion to add ordinances 7-20, 8-20 and 9-20 to the agenda seconded by Kayley Andrews, all members voted yes.

**LEGISLATION AT FIRST READING**

6-20 authorizing the issuance of notes in the amount of not to exceed \$1,245,000 in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the purpose of acquiring the existing water and sewer system from Coshocton County and retiring notes previously issued for such purpose and declaring an emergency. After the first reading Chad Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded Kayley Andrews, all members voted yes. After the second reading Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Roger Moore, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes, ordinance 6-20 passed with the emergency clause.

7-20 appropriations After the first reading Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes. After the second reading Chad Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Michelle Turner, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes, ordinance 7-20 passed with the emergency clause.

8-20 an ordinance authorizing the mayor or service director to sign all documents necessary for Ohio Department of Transportation Project PID: 101428 COS-SR83-08.29. After the first reading Roger Moore made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Chad Johnson, all members voted yes. After the second reading Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Kayley Andrews, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes, ordinance 8-20 passed with the emergency clause

9-20 an ordinance establishing trash rates and authorizing the mayor or service director to accept the bid and sign an agreement with Kimble Companies. After the first reading Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes. After the second reading ordinance will take its course.

1-20 an ordinance authorizing the Mayor or Service Director to prepare specifications, advertise and let a bid for Chlorine, Fluoride, Alum, Lime, CO2, Sodium Hexametaphosphate and Gasoline. Ordinance to take its course.
