The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Pro Tem Jackie Salmans. Items should not be placed on the agenda until discussed in committee meeting two weeks prior to council meeting. Items considered to be an emergency are to be placed on the agenda as an addition to be voted on by council to add or not add to that week's agenda. All members voted yes to amend the rules and add this section to Rule 6.
