

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: February 22, 2021 Via ZOOM**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers. Council Members present, Ms. Kayley Andrews, Mr. Mike Gross, Mr. Chad Johnson, Mr. Glenn Mishler, Mr. Roger Moore, Mr. Tom Barcroft, Ms. Michelle Turner and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk. Also, present Mr. Mark Mills, Mayor and Mr. Max Crown, Safety Service Director.

During the COVID 19 Pandemic city council meetings are being held by video conferencing via ZOOM and being broadcast live on YouTube on the Coshocton City Hall Channel.

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from 2/8/21. Glenn Mishler made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Tom Barcroft. After a roll call all members voted yes, minutes were accepted as presented.

Petitions & Remonstrance's: The public was provided an email address questions@cityofcoshocton.com to submit questions, concerns and comments during the meeting. The Mayor received a question on Facebook about the old Carnegie Library. The Mayor said the plans are for Our Town Coshocton to receive the building and open it up to the public with displays of Coshocton's history.

LEGISLATION AT FIRST READING

4-21 an ordinance to amend the City of Coshocton Codified Ordinance 1311.03 Demolition Permit. After the first reading Kayley Andrews made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Michele Turner, all members voted yes. After the second reading Roger Moore made a motion to give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Chad Johnson, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 4-21 passed.

5-21 an ordinance to amend the City of Coshocton Codified Ordinance 731 Taxicabs. Ordinance to take its course.

6-21 appropriations. After the first reading Chad Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Mike Gross, all members voted yes. After the second reading Chad Johnson made a motion to give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Tom Barcroft, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 6-21 passed with emergency clause.


Communications:
