

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: April 26, 2021 Via ZOOM**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council Pro Tem Kayley Andrews. Council Members present, Ms. Kayley Andrews, Mr. Mike Gross, Mr. Chad Johnson, Mr. Glenn Mishler, Mr. Roger Moore, Mr. Tom Barcroft, Ms. Michelle Turner and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk. Also, present Mr. Mark Mills, Mayor.

During the COVID 19 Pandemic city council meetings are being held by video conferencing via ZOOM and being broadcast live on YouTube on the Coshocton City Hall Channel.

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Pro Tem Andrews confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from 4/12/21. Chad Johnson made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Roger Moore. After a roll call all members voted yes, minutes were accepted as presented.

Petitions & Remonstrance's: The public was provided an email address questions@cityofcoshocton.com to submit questions, concerns and comments during the meeting. None were received.

Reports of Standing or Special Committees: None

City Officers Reports:

Mayor's Report: The Mayor Mills said the Preservation Arts Task Force met last week. Their focus is to preserve old buildings, and to find an area for the Pomerene Arts Center, he feels the group will do well collaborating together.

Council person Michelle Turner is to head up a committee to explore a bike path from Kids America to Lake Park.

Residents are urged to clean up their property and keep it mowed or the City will and then a lien will be placed on your taxes for the expense.

Service Director's Report: Max started by thanking the residents and organization that participated in the annual clean up day. Over 3500 pounds of trash was collected this year.

Captain Mills will be the Acting Fire Chief effective May 1st.

Starting Friday water will be going to West Lafayette, water meter installation work will continue.

Law Director's Report: Bob Skelton was present with no report

Auditor's Report: Sherry Kirkpatrick was present with no report.

Sheriff's Report: Sheriff Crawford was present his reports was emailed to council on 4/24/21.

Property Code Investigator: Jeff Corder was present with no report. He reminded residents it is against the law to mow grass onto the streets. This is a danger for motorcyclist and gets into our storm drain system. He also reminded residents to remove their trash containers from the street after their trash pick up day.

Introduction of Ordinances:

The Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (DORA) application was filed with council and the clerk tonight.

LEGISLATION AT FIRST READING

16-21 an ordinance to amend the City of Coshocton Codified Ordinance 376 Utility Task Vehicles (UTV). Ordinance to take its course.

17-21 appropriations. After the first reading Roger Moore made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Michelle Turner, all members voted yes. After the second reading Chad Johnson made a motion to give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Tom Barcroft, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 17-21 passed with emergency clause.


