

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: September 27, 2021**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Tom Hilgenberg. Council Members present, Mr. Chad Johnson, Ms. Kayley Andrews, Mr. Roger Moore, Mr. Tom Barcroft, Ms. Michelle Turner Mr. Glenn Mishler and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk. Chad Johnson made a motion to excuse Mr. Mike Gross, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes. Also, present Mark Mills, Mayor and Max Crown, Service Director.

Council Meetings are now broadcast live on YouTube on the Coshocton City Hall Channel.

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Hilgenberg confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from 9/13/21 and 8/13/21. Kayley Andrews made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Chad Johnson. After a roll call all members voted yes, minutes were accepted as presented.

Petitions & Remonstrance's: The public was provided an email address questions@cityofcoshocton.com to submit questions, concerns and comments during the meeting or invited to attend meetings in council chambers.

Jamie Elliott of Cassingham Hollow asked council to reconsider him having to get rid of his miniature horse. Mr. Elliott does not have the require acreage to have horses inside the city limits. He said the horse is being trained to be ridden but is more of a pet than a horse. Council said they would discuss his situation and get back to him.

Reports of Standing or Special Committees: None

City Officers Reports:

Mayor's Report: The Mayor Mills said he wanted to commend the Sheriff's Office for the way they handled the Roscoe Village incident over the weekend. It was very sad and tragic.

Service Director's Report: Max Crown reported that mosquito spraying was completed last week. The area was sprayed four times this year.

Law Director's Report: Bob Skelton was present and his September monthly report was emailed to council on 9/16/21.

Auditor's Report: Sherry Kirkpatrick was present and asked council to accept the donation from the Coshocton Foundation for \$8,234.60 for the City Recreation Department. Tom Barcroft made a motion to accept the donation, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes.

Sheriff's Report: Sheriff Crawford emailed his reports to council on 9/24/21. Lieutenant JD Hardway was present to represent the Sheriff's Office.

Utilities Department Report: Reports were emailed to council on 9/27/21.

Public Works Report: Reports were emailed to council on 9/27/21.

Introduction of Ordinances:

Roger Moore made a motion to add Ordinances 37-21 & 38-21 to the agenda, seconded by Michelle Turner, all members voted yes. Ordinances were added to the agenda.

LEGISLATION AT FIRST READING

37-21 an ordinance approving the settlement between the City of Coshocton and AFSCME Local #2551 and approving the funds necessary to implement the agreement and authorizing the Service Director to sign the contract with AFSCME Local #2551. After the first reading Roger Moore made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Kaylee Andrews, all members voted yes. After the second reading Michelle Turner made a

motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Chad Johnson, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 37-21 passed.

38-21 an ordinance authorizing the Service Director to sign all documents necessary for the city to purchase 0.4914 acres known as Fairy Falls Drive. After the first reading Kayley Andrews made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Tom Barcroft, all members voted yes. After the second reading Roger Moore made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Chad Johnson, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 38-21 passed.

39-21 appropriations. After the first reading Chad Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Roger Moore, all members voted yes. After the second reading Michelle Tuner made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 39-21 passed.




